



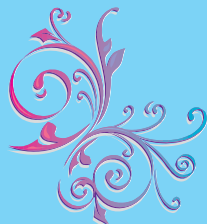

Organizations Supported in 2020-2021



Matrudham Charitable Eye Hospital in Ahmedabad, India prepared meals and fed families affected by COVID-19. Aarti Foundation donated funds to support their efforts.

The mission of Sanskar Tirth (in Ajol) is to help young women develop self-confidence and independence through education and vocational training. Each year Aarti Foundation sponsors girls and nursing students for education and provides equipment for women's upliftment (e.g., sewing machines, computers).



Niramaya Health Foundation in Mumbai, India is a non-profit organization committed to ensuring a disease-free childhood, with a focus on preventing anemia and related malnutrition in children and pregnant women. Through Aarti Foundation's donations over the past 10 years, Niramaya Health Foundation has been able to support 15,000 mal-nourished children.

AIDS Combat International (ACI) in Mumbai, India improves the quality of life of HIV-infected widows and children by reducing social stigma and discrimination through large awareness programs. Nayanam (a subdivision of ACI) supports routine screening for eye surgeries. ACI has worked tirelessly to provide medications, groceries, and educational support to COVID-19 patients and their families. Aarti Foundation, Inc. has supported ACI's projects for over 10 years.

One of the many objectives of Sanskruti Foundation is support relief projects in India. Aarti Foundation donated funds to deliver food kits to families affected by COVID-19 in Porbandar, India.

The Interfaith Nutrition Network is a homeless shelter in Hempstead, NY. For the past 15 years, Aarti Foundation, Inc. has been donating food items around the holidays so that economically disadvantaged families can enjoy a hot meal.
